Year One Services: Planning, Training & Pilot Launch

- Monthly site visits from the US PREP Regional Transformation Support Specialist
- Weekly (virtual) planning meetings
- Co-development of the US PREP Individual Transformation Plans and Quarterly Outcome Reviews
- Access to the US PREP Resource Toolkit and US PREP Data Dashboard
- Leadership coaching and workshops to include (1) how to lead and scale change in a university, (2) examining and restructuring current budget models, and (3) creating plans for scaling initiatives
